The Evolution of a Barn, The History

Originally an 1871 barn of the Long family's farm, has enjoyed a marvelous evolution the past century engendering a long tradition rich in history. In 1940, William Barstow, an engineer and philanthropist from New York, purchased the farm and converted the barn into a wayside tavern as a hobby for his wife, Françoise. Barstow, a close associate and life-long friend of Thomas Edison, acquired his fortune through the development of electricity.

Having seen an intriguing "inn for sale" ad in the New York Times, William and Margery Wolfe visited Chittenden and began an immediate love affair with the Inn and its superb location. In 1945 they purchased the property and approximately 500 acres.

Throughout the ensuing years, improvements and additions to the original building were made maintaining the integrity of its New England origin and the beauty and ecology of its natural surroundings. The Inn was proud to play host to President Eisenhower and his entourage during a fishing expedition in 1955.

By 1964, realizing the terrain was a natural for cross country skiing, began to develop a ski center and trail system. Today, with over 85 kilometers of trails, The Cross Country Ski Touring Center boasts some of the best Nordic skiing in the United States.

In January 1977, a fire destroyed the majority of the original Inn. After two years of deliberation, Bill Wolfe decided to rebuild the Inn with traditional post and beam construction. The large Douglas fir beams which span the Inn lend warmth and charm while the large windows and glass "silo" staircase take advantage of the incredible panoramic views.

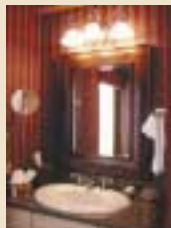
